**Year 4-** In Science we have been creating models to demonstrate how climate has changed over time.

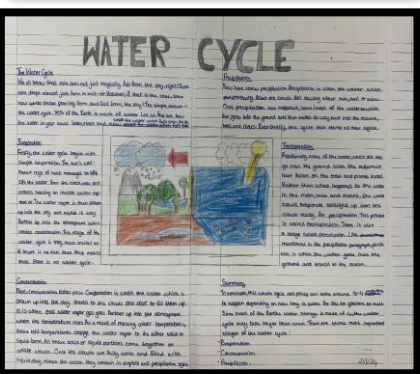
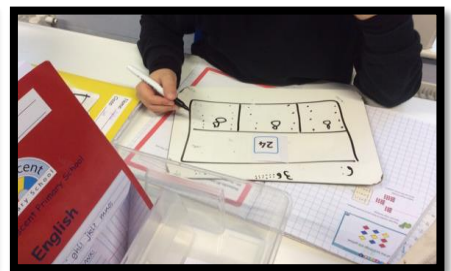
**Baby & Toddler group-** Stay & Play
