Reception- The children were making bread, and looking at the different stages. They got to taste the finished bread.

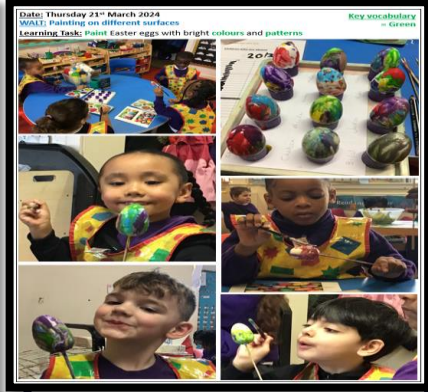
Year 2- This was an amazing trip to The Arc Animal centre. The children fed monkeys and Capybara and saw dancing parrots!
