Year 3-Taking part in "Just Dance" to learn about hand, eye coordination & balance.

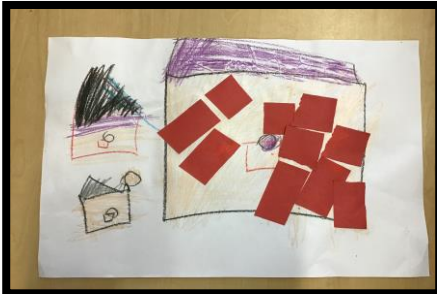
Also looking at Heavy/light and mass in maths
