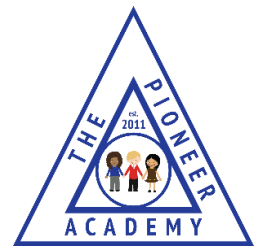

UNIFORM FOR ALL RECEPTION, YEAR 1 & 2 CHILDREN

- Crew neck sweatshirt or sweat cardigan both with school logo
- White polo shirt, plain or with school logo
- Grey trousers/shorts, grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Grey socks, white socks or grey tights
- Summer dress – lilac and white check only (optional)
- Black shoes (**NO TRAINERS/NO PICTURES**)

For safety reasons we will not allow open toe sandals or 'jelly' shoes.

Please don't buy lace up shoes until your child can competently tie them themselves. Shoelaces can easily come undone and this can be very dangerous in a busy playground.

PE KIT

- Purple T-shirt with school logo
- Black P.E shorts
- Black plimsolls or plain trainers
- Plain black/grey tracksuit for use if needed during outdoor PE
- P.E bag with logo

We do not allow children to take part in PE lessons if they do not have the correct PE kit.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Book bag with logo
- Infant backpack with logo
- School coat with logo
- Winter hats/sun hats (baseball & legionnaire style)

Religious headwear for both boys and girls must only be plain black, white, purple or grey. Only short hijabs may be worn.

OUR APPROACH TO PE

- Please note that if your child wears earrings, they must only be stud earrings, not hoops or larger earrings. Children must be able to remove their earrings by themselves, or tape them up (with tape provided) in order to take part in PE.
- If you do not provide a PE kit in school for your child, they will be given a clean PE Kit that they must wear for their PE lesson.
